Acts Part 30

“Paul’s First Sermon of Record”



13 Now Paul and his companions put out to sea from Paphos and came to Perga in Pamphylia; but John left them and returned to Jerusalem. 14 But going on from Perga, they arrived at Pisidian Antioch, and on the Sabbath day they went into the synagogue and sat down.

16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

15 After the reading of the Law and the Prophets, the synagogue officials sent *word* to them, saying, “Brothers, if you have any word of exhortation for the people, say it.” **16** Paul stood up, and motioning with his hand said, “Men of Israel, and you who fear God, listen:

17 The God of this people Israel chose our fathers and made the people great during their stay in the land of Egypt, and with an uplifted arm He led them out from it. 18 For a period of about forty years He put up with them in the wilderness.

21 Then they asked for a king, and God gave them Saul the son of Kish, a man of the tribe of Benjamin, for forty years. 22 After He had removed him, He raised up David to be their king, concerning whom He also testified and said, 'I have found David, the son of Jesse, a man after My heart, who will do all My will.'

23 From the descendants of this man, according to promise, God has brought to Israel a Savior, Jesus, 24 after John had proclaimed, before His coming, a baptism of repentance to all the people of Israel.

25 And while John was completing his course, he kept saying, 'What do you suppose that I am? I am not *He*. But behold, one is coming after me, the sandals of whose feet I am not worthy to untie.'

26 "Brothers, sons of Abraham's family, and those among you who fear God, to us the message of this salvation has been sent. 27 For those who live in Jerusalem, and their rulers, recognizing neither Him nor the declarations of the prophets which are read every Sabbath, fulfilled *these* by condemning *Him*.

28 And though they found no grounds for *putting Him to death*, they asked Pilate that He be executed. 29 When they had carried out everything that was written concerning Him, they took Him down from the cross and laid Him in a tomb.

30 But God raised Him from the dead; 31 and for many days He appeared to those who came up with Him from Galilee to Jerusalem, the very ones who are now His witnesses to the people.

**32 And we preach to you the good news of the *promise* made to the fathers, 33 that God has fulfilled this promise to those of us *who are the* descendants by raising Jesus, as it is also written in the second Psalm:
'YOU ARE MY SON; TODAY I HAVE FATHERED YOU.'**

34 As for the fact that He raised Him from the dead, never again to return to decay, He has spoken in this way: 'I WILL GIVE YOU THE HOLY AND FAITHFUL MERCIES OF DAVID.' 35 Therefore, He also says in another Psalm: 'YOU WILL NOT ALLOW YOUR HOLY ONE TO UNDERGO DECAY.'

36 For David, after he had served God's purpose in his own generation, fell asleep, and was buried among his fathers and underwent decay; 37 but He whom God raised did not undergo decay.
